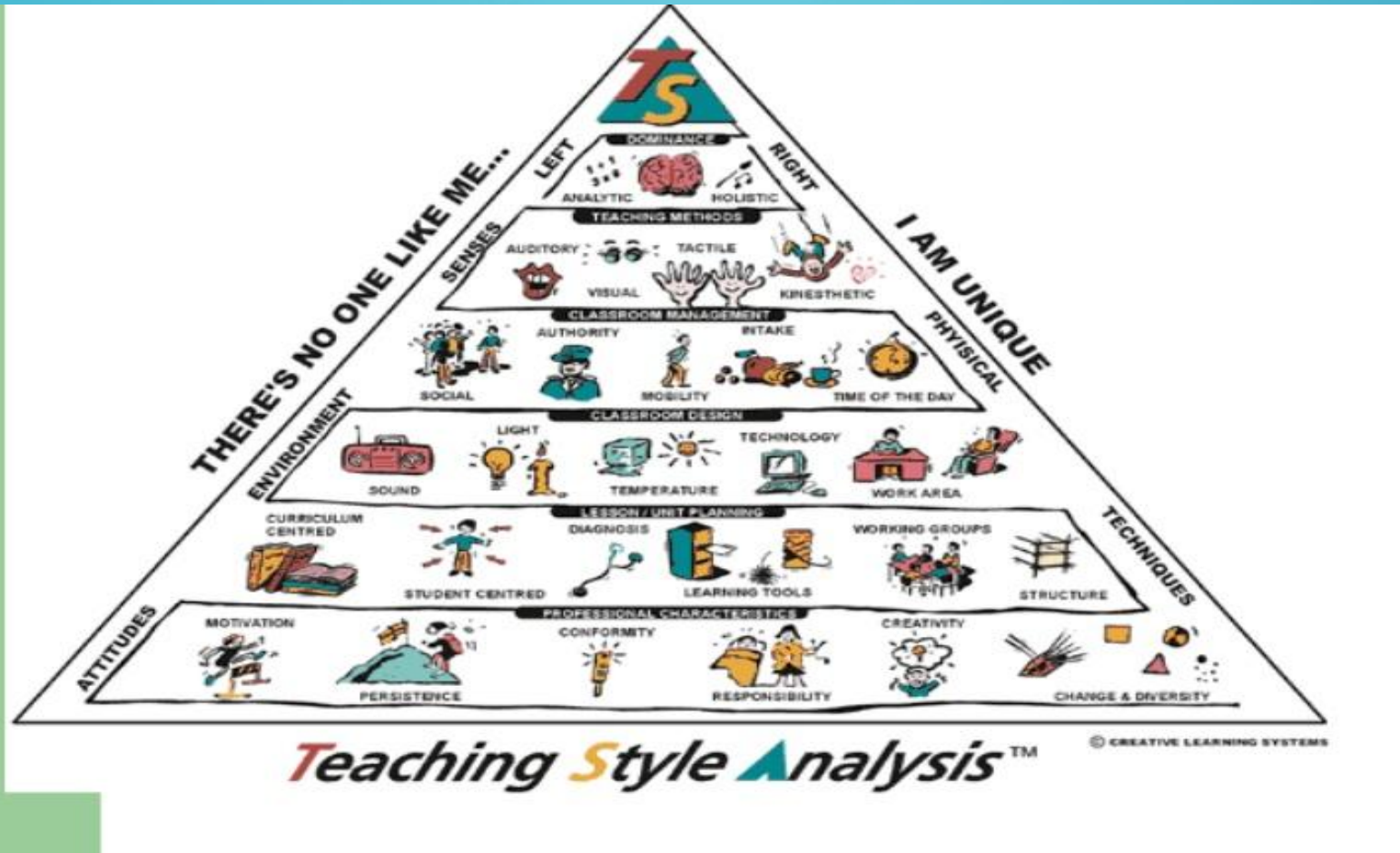




Students create a lesson using two pieces of technology
