We lost the \$200/ students who were eligible for college and career readiness (about \$18,000) not using IXL- didn't get the data from them to be able to evaluate the effectiveness of program Student success office (AP and Coordinator)-haven't hired yet

Distance Learning

Swindell- students were frustrated with technology issues. Overall positive attitudes from students, they are glad to be back.

What are some of our support staff doing?

Campus monitors have responsibilities. Many end of the year closing procedures since we left the building early. They will have direct responsibilities every day, including home visits, wellness checks, and opportunities to learn other skills that may allow them to cross train.

Long- How will we address discipline issues online? We will have more abilities to control students entering and exiting the class. Students will not be able to access the google meet classroom after the teacher leaves the meet.

Kimes- How can we work with students in a positive way (SEL) so after a behavioral incident we can get students back into class and they have a good attitude.

A re-engagement plan

Price- students must use their school gmail account to log into classes and to send emails to teachers and staff.

Long- Can we record class for discipline purposes? Adn not share it? No, without parental consent we may not record.

Price- recommended that teachers may want to record their lesson outside of live direct instruction time.

Adams- in giving teachers choice, an instructor may find that their direct instruction may be more enriching for viewers in case questions may arise that can clarify some points that learners may have.
